Method will be First Received. No hand deliveries the first 24 hours of opening.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Electronic timers will be used.

Notice to Exhibitors

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

- * Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * All dogs MUST be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.
- * Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries WILL be returned. Fill in all the blanks, please.
- * EVENT COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
- * All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- * BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. After closing, upon presentation of a written veterinary certificate there will be refund minus \$10.00 per day processing fee for bitches in season and injured dogs. No AKC fee for bitches in season. An injury is any wound or damage to the body resulting from physical activity. Some common injury types are: cut, abrasion, fracture and burn. Sprain and strain injuries to muscles, joints and connective tissues are classified as injuries. All documentation must be received by the trial secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Awards

ACSI will give out green ribbons to all qualifiers. Ribbons will be given out to 1st-4th placements in all regular and preferred classes. In T2B, only 1st place will be awarded.

Move Ups

Dogs may be moved at the request of the owner, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing. (E- Mail is acceptable) All moves must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than 6PM on Monday, August 3, 2023**. Day-to-day moves over the weekend will be accepted but must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event (by the end of that day's trial). Moving down or changing of height after closing except is accepted as specified in Chapter 1 Section 20 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

Jump Height Divisions

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has a spot to indicate if the dog needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running. The jump height box on the entry form **MUST** be filled in.

Important Trial Site Notes

- Tarps or other waterproof mats **MUST** be used under all crates to protect turf spills and pet hair. Tarps will be available for purchase from ACSI if you don't have one.
- No grooming is allowed inside the building. Please help us keep the facility tidy by picking up any excess pet hair and all trash around your crating space.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused from the trial without refund. A \$10 fee will be charged for any dog soiling the turf
- This facility requires any chair with 4 individual feet to be placed on a thick mat/rug/pad to protect the turf. Only chairs with a solid bar for feet, such as anti-gravity chairs, may sit directly on the turf.

From I-265, take Exit 4 for Charlestown Rd. Turn south toward New Albany. Continue for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Silver Street. Turn left into Silver Street Park.

Early Crating

ACSI will allow early crating for \$10 per mat that you put down. Early crating will be available 6:30-7 pm Friday before the trial. This time is subject to change based on the park's schedule, but every effort will be made to communicate any changes as soon as possible. Keep an eye out for emails from the trial secretary or check our Facebook page ([ACSI Agility Club](#)).

Mixed Height Entries

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

There is no RV parking allowed on-site. Parking is adequate for cars/trucks/SUVs, but we unfortunately do not have room to accommodate RVs/ travel trailers on-site. There are a few campgrounds in the area and a Walmart about a mile from the trial site on Grant Line Road.

International Sweepstakes Class (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<https://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: **ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials.** There is no Preferred Option for ISC; *dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.*

Jump Heights: **DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS,** however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- ☐ Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾" or less at the withers
- ☐ Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾" and up to 16 7/8" at the withers
- ☐ Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8" at the withers.
- ☐ Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 16 7/8" at the withers

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
