DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

I57S: would be exit at the Curtis Road exit and turn left off the exit and onto Curtis. Turn right onto Rising Road and continue on Rising Road until the 4 way stop at Bradley and then turn left onto Bradley. Bark And Run is the blue building on your left.

I57N: exit at Olympian Dr and turn right off the exit. Take a left onto Mattis Ave. Continue on Mattis until you reach Bradley Ave and turn right onto Bradley. Continue on Bradley Ave for a few miles heading out of town and Bark And Run will be after the intersection of Rising Rd and Bradley Rd. Bark And Run is a blue building on the left.

I74W: Take exit 174, Prairieview Road. Turn left onto US 150. Right onto Rising Rd. At the 4-way stop of Rising Rd and Bradley, turn right. The big blue building coming up on your left is it. The drive for that building is directly after a small bridge.

I74E: get off at the Prospect Ave. exit. Prospect south to Bradley Ave. Continue on Bradley Ave for a few miles heading out of town and Bark And Run will be after the intersection of Rising Rd and Bradley Rd. Bark And Run is a blue building on the left.

I72: Take the Mahomet 47 exit and turn left onto 47. Take the first right onto 1700 (Bradley Rd). Continue on Bradley just past Barker Road and Bark And Run is the blue building on your right.

Note: GPS does not always give the correct location to the property.

SITE INFORMATION

There is plenty of space for parking onsite. There is limited room for crating in the air-conditioned building; please place a mat under your crate. No building access Friday, crates may be left in the building Saturday night. DTCCU is not responsible for any damaged or lost items left at the show site. No dogs may be left overnight.

No food will be available on site. There are various restaurants and fast-food places within a short driving distance.

AKC regs require that dogs must be on leash, crated, or otherwise under physical control at all times on the trial grounds when not competing or at the practice jump. Exhibitors must clean up after their dog. Any exhibitor failing to do either will be excused without benefit of refund.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. DTCCU and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. DTCCU reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against DTCCU or any official thereof.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, flood, extreme weather conditions, act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will be refunded in full if a written request (mail/email) is received by the trial secretary on or before trial closing date.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. The club will refund the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason; a written request must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour before the start of the first class of the day. A dated letter or bill (including handler or dog name; personal details should be redacted from bill) from a doctor or veterinarian indicating the issue may be required for a \$10/run refund for a handler or dog that is unable to compete due to illness or injury; a written request must be received by the trial secretary ½ hour before the start of judging on Saturday.

CATALOGS

Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$8; \$10 if purchased at trial.

Express mail entries must include a signature waiver. No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing date. Email changes are welcomed. The trial secretary will confirm receipt of all emails – if you do not receive a reply within a few days, your email was not received. The trial secretary is not responsible for emails not received.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on entry forms. Please read your confirmation emails.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Club will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. No refund will be given for overpayment of less than \$10.00. No refunds for duplicate entries. Envelopes containing entries for more than the 10 dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as invalid and shall be returned to the sender.

Email confirmation of entries will be sent after an entry is received and entered into the database. Please make sure your email address is legible. Final confirmations with the judging schedule & preliminary running order will be sent after the closing date and posted on the DTCCU event website.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class – this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, **all** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before its first run of the weekend*. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs should be physically sound. Blind dogs shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2, Registration & Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to 1st-4th place dogs in each height except T2B, where only 1st is awarded. Prizes must be claimed at the trial.

New Title rosettes will be available to teams finishing a title. MACH, PACH, PAX, or AGCH rosette and jump bar will be awarded to teams that attain their MACH, PACH, PAX, or AGCH at these trials. Only one bar & ribbon will be awarded for a dog who earns both PACH & PAX at these trials.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles meet the specifications in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes indoors in a 70' X 120' ring on soccer turf with rubber pellet infill.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

The warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Recent Permanent AKC Changes:

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Note: The Double Q requires that Standard Agility and JWW be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, a dog may be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) – Offered at these trials

FEO is only allowed in all agility classes.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class prior to the closing date, pay class entry fees, and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Exc, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. FNG is not pre-entered and may be used in any class.

Leash Policy

When running the course, leashes may be worn or put in pockets. If the dog grabs the leash while running, this will be scored as "E".

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners**™ program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior to the Owner?
